Bougainvillea 'Barbara Karst':

This showy vine works well in a variety of garden themes, from Tropical to Mediterranean. Barbara Karst is a fast grower and has become very popular because of its gorgeous fuchsia flowers. It offers a fine cover to trellises and arbors, but can also be grown successfully as a groundcover. After established, these plants become drought tolerant and require very little maintenance and irrigation.

Escallonia 'Fradesii': Glossy, green leaves and a year-round show of prolific rose-pink flowers makes this plant a success in any garden. Because of its fast, compact growth to 5-6 ft. high and wide this plant is desirable for screens and hedges. Escallonia tolerates strong coastal winds and most soil conditions. Beneficial insects, such as bees, are attracted to this plant making it a smart addition to your garden.



Iceberg Rose: Beautiful Iceberg roses are a garden essential with their pure white blooms and mild honey fragrance. Starting in early spring, flowers are produced in abundance with very little care. This floribunda's extreme disease resistance and vigorous growth has earned it a spot amongst the top ten roses in the world and a place in the World Rose Hall of Fame. This rose can be used as a hedge, shrub or accent plant. The contrast between the dark green foliage and the bright white flowers make it a winning choice for all situations.
