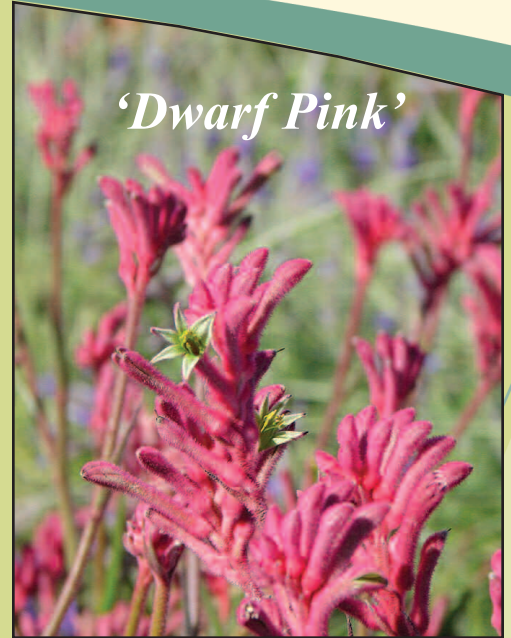

Check out our Anigozanthos...

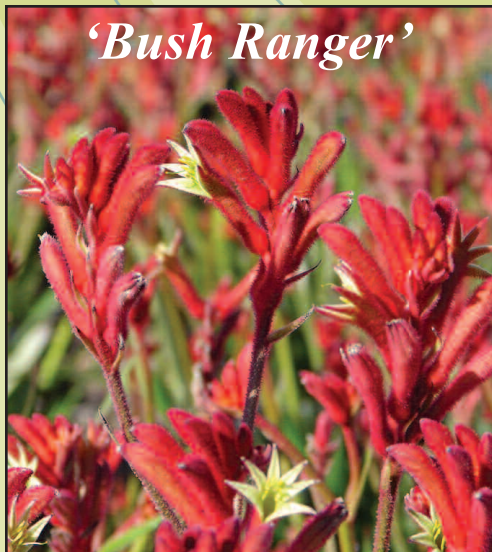
Kangaroo Paws are becoming increasingly popular in landscapes. They come in a wide variety of vibrant colors and display unique tubular shaped flowers. They are generally disease resistant, long lived, and have a long flowering season.

Use these simple steps to keep your Anigozanthos looking great!

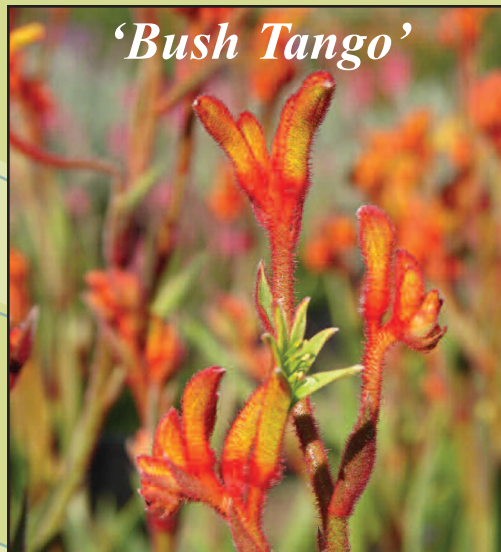
- Plant in well-draining soil. Provide plants with regular water in the summer to help ensure your plants stay evergreen.
- Plant in an open and sunny area. If you live in an area prone to frost, plant on the south side of the house under eaves or near a tree with a high canopy.
- Remove old flower stocks and cut leaves as low as possible at the end of the season. This will also promote new flower growth. Be careful not to harm new growth when cutting back the old.
- Feed lightly and with a low phosphorus fertilizer.



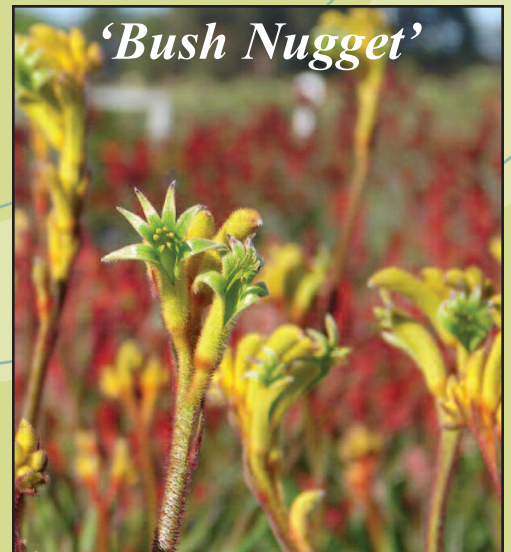
